Digital Music Mixing

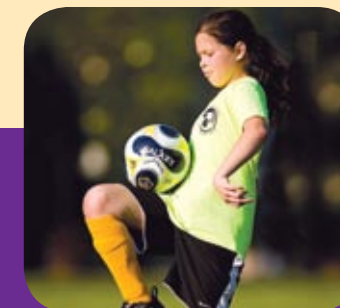
