What are the 7 Catholic Social Teachings and some examples of service that could be performed?

1. The value of life and dignity of the human person - Services: Respect life programs, donate blood, baby clothes collection
 2. The call to family, community, and participation - Services: assist with liturgies as a musician or server, lead a retreat, assist with school sponsored benefit activities
 3. The rights and responsibilities of every person - Services: participate in Youth Challenge, volunteer at Camp Cheerful, walk in peaceful protests
 4. The preferential option for the poor and vulnerable – Services: volunteer at a food bank, tutor for underprivileged students, participate in the Arupe program
 5. The dignity of work and rights of workers – Services: organize event to raise awareness of world injustices, help with Saint Joseph Academy phone-a-thon
 6. Love of neighbor and solidarity with all – Services: participate or work a benefit walk, assist with Sunday school, volunteer at a local hospital
 7. Care for God's creation – Services: help with a clean up campaign, clean up an elderly person's yard, assist with a recycling program
