Expectations of Behavior at Saint Joseph Academy Dances

Saint Joseph Academy must uphold Christian moral principles in regard to behavior and attire of students who attend school dances.

The following behaviors are expected of all students who attend Saint Joseph Academy dances:

- The young women who attend a dance are expected to be attired in a way that projects a look of modesty. Although not a complete list of examples, the following styles **should not** be worn: bare midriffs, see-through tops, and exposed undergarments, etc.
- The young men who attend a dance are expected to remain in appropriate attire. This includes keeping dress shirts on throughout the evening.
- Because the dance is held in the Academy Center students are encouraged to wear flip flops or athletic shoes; high heels are not permitted.
- Dancing should also reflect proper modesty. Although not a complete list of examples, the following types of dancing would not be acceptable: sexually explicit dancing, grinding, and other lewd dancing.
- Dances are drug-free and alcohol-free events.

Students who violate these principles are subject to:

- Immediate dismissal from the dance
- A call to their parents, and/or a call to school officials of which the student attends
- In the case of a Saint Joseph Academy student, further disciplinary action may be taken.
- In case of unlawful behavior, police officers at the dance may be notified.

Saint Joseph Academy reserves the right to use alcohol detecting instruments at any school activities.

All those in attendance at the dance must bring a form of identification i.e.: a school id or driver's license.
